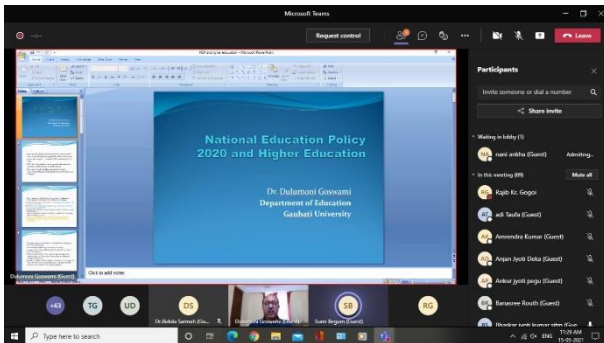
### **KEY PRINCIPLES OF NEP 2020**

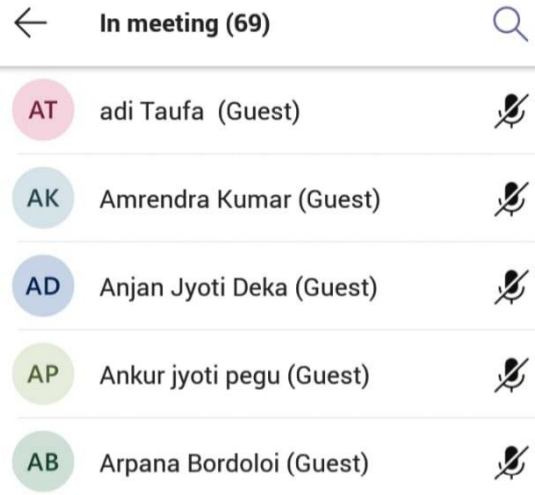

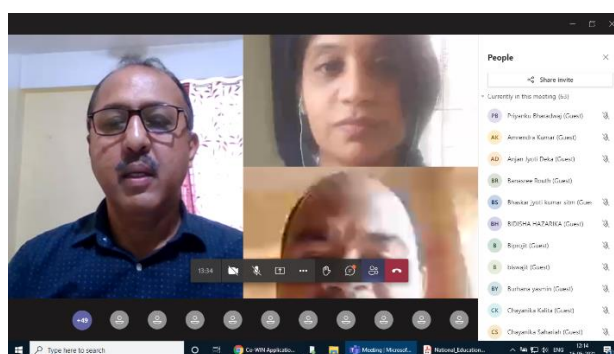
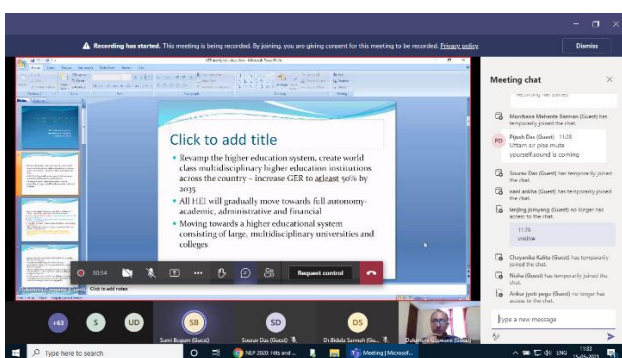
